Town of Greenwood Ordinance No. 2018-03 Designating All Through Town Roads as Class B

STATE OF WISCONSIN Town of Greenwood Vernon County

SECTION I - TITLE AND PURPOSE

The title of this ordinance is the Town of Greenwood Ord. No. 2018-03 Designating All Through Town Roads as Class B. The purpose of this ordinance is to restrict the transport of heavy truck loads on all town roads within the Town of Greenwood to protect the town roads and prolong the service life of town roads.

SECTION II - AUTHORITY

The Town Board of the Town of Greenwood, Vernon County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority to adopt this Town Road Class B Ordinance under Section 349.17 Wis. stats.

SECTION III - ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE

This ordinance, adopted on proper notice with a quorum and roll call vote by a majority of the town board present and voting, provides the authority for the town to designate all through town roads as Class B.

SECTION IV – TRANSPORT OF LOADS ON TOWN ROADS

No person shall operate a vehicle with a load in excess of the weights as described in the definition of Class B restrictions, (348.16 Wis. stats), unless the load meets the exemptions as specified under 348.16 and is to be delivered to, or picked up from, a property within the Town of Greenwood, or the operator has applied for and obtained a permit to exceed the class B weight restrictions from the Patrolman or Town Board designee for the Town of Greenwood. If the permit is denied, a reason will be documented.

A vehicle whose load exceeds the limits under Wis. Stats 348.16, whose travel begins within the Town of Greenwood must use a route which entails the shortest travel on Greenwood Town roads in order to access a class A road to reach its final destination.

SECTION VII - ENFORCEMENT

Enforcement of the Class B road restriction shall be accomplished through the Vernon County Sheriff's office and the Wisconsin State Patrol.

SECTION VIII - PENALTIES

The penalty for violating the Town of Greenwood class B restriction shall be as defined under s. 348.21

SECTION IX - SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are severable.

SECTION X - EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance is effective on publication or posting.

The town clerk shall properly publish this ordinance as required under s. <u>60.80</u>, Wis. stats.
